

Leeds Luminaries Alumni Awards Policy

Awards criteria

- 1.1. Leeds Luminaries is an annual awards scheme to honour high-achieving alumni of Leeds Grammar School, Leeds Girls' High School and The Grammar School at Leeds, whose success professionally or personally inspires others to succeed.
- 1.2. Award winners will have demonstrated the school's core values of excellence, inspiration and citizenship.
- 1.3. There aren't specific awards categories. Leeds Luminaries Awards are generic honours awards.

2. Eligibility – nominees and nominators

- 2.1 Nominees will be an alumni of the school. Alumni in this case includes former pupils or staff of LGS, LGHS or GSAL.
- 2.2 Former pupils of LGS, LGHS and GSAL, current pupils of the school, former or current staff and former and current parents of the school are eligible to nominate.
- 2.3 Nominators can nominate as many people as they wish.
- 2.4 Previous winners of a Leeds Luminaries Award are not eligible but previous nominees are.
 - 2.4.1. Previous winners of a Leeds Luminaries Award are Baroness Pauline Neville-Jones, Lady Valerie Solti, Lucy Harris, Barry Brindley, Shaan and Haaris Ahmed, Zoe Hudson and Graeme Lee.
- 2.5 Nominators must complete a nomination form either online or by post for each nominee.
- 2.6 Nominations cannot be made anonymously.
- 2.7 Nominees will not be informed unless successful and/or unless more information is required.

3. Selection process

- 3.1 The winners will be decided by the Leeds Luminaries Awards Committee.
- 3.2 Members of the committee include the Principal, a member of the alumni relations team, three current or former members of staff from LGS, LGHS and GSAL, the Presidents of the OLA and OGC.
- 3.3 There isn't a limit to the number of winners per year.
- 3.4 Awards will only be given to nominees who are judged by the committee to have fulfilled the criteria effectively in section 1.



3.5 The committee's decision is final.

4. Communication

4.1 Awards winners will be notified by email.

4.2 Awards winners reserve the right to accept or decline the award and/or for their details to be published.

4.3 Winners, who have given the appropriate permission will be announced in Memento magazine and across various other communication channels.

5. Award presentation

5.1 Winners will be invited to receive their awards at The Grammar School at Leeds Senior School Speech Day.
